*The FY 2014 Consolidated Appropriations Act changed the definition of extremely low-income to be the greater of 30/50ths (60%) of the Section 8 very low-income limit or the poverty guideline as est. by HHS, provided that this amount is not greater than the Section 8 50% VLI limit. Consequently, the ELI limits may equal the VL (50%) income limits.

**These are calculated on the 50% X 2 as the 100% number. This number is rounded according to HUD data so we don't know what the real 100% number is. Therefore, these may change.
